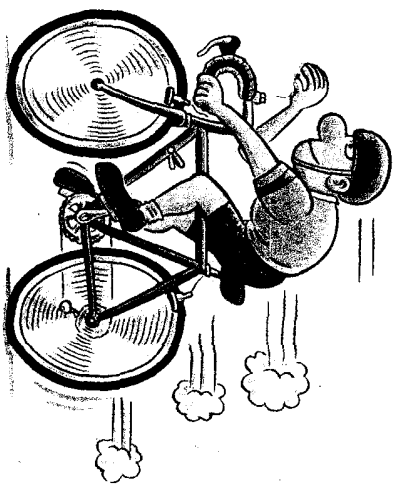

THE MINISTRY

The World Hunger Bike Ride is but one element of the World Hunger Auction which is an outreach ministry of the following northern Franklin County Church of the Brethren Congregations:

Antioch, Bethany, Bethlehem, Boones Mill, Cedar Bluff, Fairview, Germantown Brick, Monte Vista, Oak Grove(South), and Smith Mountain Lake. The auction this year will be August 11 at the Antioch Church beginning at 10am.

Proceeds from the Bike Ride and other Auction functions in past years have been distributed to the Heavenly Manna Food Bank in Rocky Mount, RAM (Roanoke Area Ministries) House in Roanoke, Heifer Project International (Honduras) and Heifer Project - (Appalachian Region).

What is Heifer Project? It is a nonprofit Christian organization, working in partnership with 13 denominations, that has helped more than one million impoverished families around the world become more self-reliant through the gift of livestock and training in its care. Thousands of individual donors and congregations throughout the world provide the funds to make possible these gifts of life. The first animals given by Heifer Project were 17 heifers sent to families in Puerto Rico in 1944. Their mahourished children had never before tasted cow's milk. Today, families and communities in approximately 110 countries and 35 states are leading self-reliant lives as a result of the work of Heifer Project.
